There is a lot of documentation to include paperwork, videos, Facebook screenshots, Wireless Detection Reports, internal signage and reported verbal/text/email communications, and more to follow this initial complaint. I delivered the event-oriented counseling from CSM Emekaekwue (20221212) and my Non-Standard Physical Security and Information Security Officer ADOs to you personally at the IG office yesterday (20221212). The Co. CDRs actions should be reported for adjudication per USASOC 25-2. I have confidence in the DCSA's adjudication process. The more I attempt to proactively promote INFOSEC programs the more resistance and perceived allegations are levied at me verbally and now it seems it is getting physical. I was invited upon request to stand in front of BN formation during our last formation of the CY22 and was physically pushed back into formation prior to completion and not asked back to complete this important message This action caused many in the formation to laugh at me and, unfortunately, diffused this important National Security message. I professionally direct SMs to remove PEDs when discovered. More evidence to follow.
